But do these goals have to be mutually exclusive? New research suggests that teachers really can have it both ways, using research-based techniques to strengthen both what students know and their ability to use that knowledge. In this interactive plenary talk, cognitive psychologist Michelle Miller will invite faculty to look at memory in a new light, offering tools and techniques that help students build a solid base of knowledge efficiently, quickly, and with a side order of fun.
